Gala Conditions

- The meet is to be held at Knowsley Leisure & Culture Park, Longview Drive, Huyton, L36 6EG, on Saturday 30th March & Sunday 31st March 2019 Closing date for entries is Monday 11th March 2019.
- 2. Age on the day will be as of midnight 31st March 2019.
- 3. Entry fees each event £5.00 for electronic entries £5.50 for paper entries. Electronic entries can be made using the Sports Systems meet file which can be obtained by e-mailing external events@prescotswimmingclub.org or downloading from the Prescot SC website.
- 4. Coaches' passes are available at £20.00 each. It is mandatory that all coaches comply with the relevant ASA Child Safeguarding procedures and have an up to date CRB certificate/DBS registration.
- Times (25m Pool Size or converted to 25m) required for all events. Competitor age is at midnight 31st March 2019. Please check the correct age group is entered relative to the swimmers date of birth.
- 6. As a level 3 meet there are upper time limits, swimmers must not have swim faster than or equal to the times listed in the upper qualifying times in this entry pack.
- 7. Details on the entry forms should be as per the swimmers ASA Category 2 Membership Registration and as shown on the ASA Membership Database. Please check that your swimmers (including 9yr olds) are Category 2 registered, and their ASA ID number is correct. Entries sent without fee, with entries incorrectly made out or declaration not signed may not be accepted. No refunds for entries incorrectly submitted. Entries should preferably be sent electronically by an authorised club official or a single entry by post for each club.
- 8. Over the Top starts will be used, with the exception of backstroke events. All events are heat declared.
- 9. Withdrawals must be made on an official withdrawal form. To help the event run smoothly withdrawals must be made no later than 40 minutes before the start of each session.
- 10. Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves to the marshals in good time for the event in which they are competing. It is the swimmers' responsibility to be at the start in time for the race.
- 11. Restriction of entries. The promoter reserves the right to restrict entries in the interest of safety, time constraints and to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Where this rule is invoked the swimmers with the fastest submitted times in each age group shall take precedence. Events chosen for restriction will be at the discretion of the promoter. A refund will be given to competitors whose entry is denied where this condition has been exercised. Poolside entries will be taken at the discretion of the promoter.
- 12. Anything not covered within these meet rules to be at the discretion of the meet organiser/promoter.
- 13. Knowsley Leisure and Culture Park has a large main foyer with seating and café area. There are two 25m pools. The competition will be run in the eight lane 25m pool of graduated depth with spectator viewing gallery to seat 314. Anti-wave lane ropes and turn boards will be used. The 25m four lane teaching pool of variable depth will be used as a warm-up/swim down facility only. Each Club will be responsible for providing a Coach to supervise their own Club swimmers while in the warm up/swim down pool.
 - Spectator entry for whole day £9:00 (£5:00 per Session)

14. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals will be awarded in the following age groups;

9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & Over
An award will be presented for top Girl/Boy and top visiting Team with the most gala points.
Points will be awarded as follows
1st = 6pts, 2nd = 5pts, 3rd = 4pts, 4th = 3pts, 5th = 2pts, 6th = 1pt
In the event of a tie positions will be determined by the most 1st, 2nd positions etc.
Swimmers are to collect their awards as the competition proceeds

Rules for Skins Events

1, The SKINS race distance will be 50m

1A - The fastest 8 x 200M Individual Medley times for both Male & Female will be selected from entries received.

2. Both the male and female events will begin with up to 8 male and 8 female swimmers

3. Male Skins will be on the Saturday & Female Skins will be on the Sunday

4, The chairmen will select the stroke for each race through a random process such as drawing slips from a hat. Each time, the slip will be returned to the hat prior to the next race selection.

5. Each start will be made according to ASA starting procedure. The starter will give the command 'Take your Marks' and will then attempt to give the starting signal on the 1.5 minute time slot for each race.

6. If a swimmer is 'moving at the start' the heat will continue and the swimmer 'moving at the start' will be eliminated at the end of the race instead of the slowest swimmer in that particular race.

7. If a swimmer "False Starts" and enters the water the remaining swimmers will be stood down and the race re-started when it is safe to do so. Health and Safety of all the swimmers is very important and the race cannot be re-started until safe to do so. The swimmer who "false started" will be eliminated instead of the slowest swimmer in that race.

8. If a swimmer is disqualified for a stroke infringement then they will be eliminated and not the slowest swimmer in that race. Strokes will be in accordance with FINA laws and Technical Rules.

9. The referee will determine the slowest swimmer, who is to be eliminated in each round using either Automatic Officiating Equipment (AOE) or placing judges and will inform the slowest or disqualified swimmer of this following every race. To determine this, if AOE is used, the referee will determine whether it operated correctly. If the placing judges determine the slowest swimmer, they will make the referee aware of their decision. The referee will then inform the eliminated swimmer. If the Placing Judges disagree on the swimmer to be eliminated, the Referee will make the decision. If no clear decision can be reached (e.g. a dead heat) all swimmers will swim in the next heat, where two swimmers will be eliminated

10. The races proceed according to these rules with the races in each event being 1.5 minutes apart, until there is an overall male and female winner.

11. Swimmers will remain in their original assigned lanes throughout the event other than during the final, where the two middle lanes will be used.

12. At the end of each race, the Referee will enter on the swimmer's timecard the place attained in the event (i.e. 6th, 3rd, 5th etc).




